- 6 Corte Vigna** 250ml Glass £4.65
Chardonnay delle Venezie, ITALY 175ml Glass £3.40
From the north east of Italy this wine has recently been upgraded to IGT classification. It is aromatic with a lovely peach and nectarine finish. IGT (Indicazione Geografica Tipica) is a big step up from Vino da Tavola (basic Italian table wine).
- 10 Cullinan View Chenin Blanc,** 250ml Glass £4.95
Robertson, SOUTH AFRICA 175ml Glass £3.65
Deliciously fresh and creamy with peachy fruit character. A classic South African style.
- 12 Tierra Sauvignon Blanc,** 250ml Glass £4.95
Maule Valley, CHILE 175ml Glass £3.65
Pale yellow with fresh fruit, citrus and mineral notes and a clean finish.
- 18 Pinot Grigio Provincia di Pavia,** 250ml Glass £5.50
Collezione Marchesini, ITALY 175ml Glass £3.95
A lovely buttery wine, with typical pear fruit, that comes from the southern section of Lombardy in central northern Italy. Cool fermented for maximum fruit and acidity retention.

ROSÉ

- 61 Cullinan View Chenin Blanc Rosé,** 250ml Glass £4.95
Robertson, SOUTH AFRICA 175ml Glass £3.75
Vibrant rosé made in an off-dry style, lovely crisp zing with summer berry fruit flavours.

- 33 Casa La Joya Cabernet Sauvignon,** 250ml Glass **£5.25**
Colchagua Valley, CHILE 175ml Glass **£3.85**
The balance of rich berry flavours and a soft minted finish perfected by this family-owned winery.
- 36 Hardys 'The Riddle' Shiraz-Cabernet,** 250ml Glass **£5.25**
SE Australia, AUSTRALIA 175ml Glass **£3.85**
The unusual name 'The Riddle' is in reference to the skill needed to solve the problem of blending two different parcels together to make the finished wine. The palate combines the pepper, spice and raspberry flavours of the Shiraz with the blackcurrant and firm rich tannins of the Cabernet. This is finished off with a light touch of toasty vanilla oak. Riddle solved.
- 42 Corte Vigna Merlot delle Venezie** 250ml Glass **£4.65**
ITALY 175ml Glass **£3.40**
Fresh and lively with lots of easy-drinking summer fruit flavours, a hint of smoky overtones and a soft jammy finish.
- 47 Faustino VII Rioja Tinto** 250ml Glass **£6.30**
SPAIN 175ml Glass **£4.50**
Made from 100% Tempranillo grapes. Aromas of spice, leather and vanilla are created by ageing in American oak for 10 months, followed by a minimum of 6 months in bottle. A great sociable Rioja, especially at this price.

| | Lugny is one of the most famous villages in the Maconnais, producing exceptional fragrant and elegant white wines, this one has floral and apple aromas with a hint of lemon. | |
| 2 | Chablis Gloire de Chablis,
J. Moreau et Fils, FRANCE | £29.95 |
| | This pale gold wine is fruity on the nose, with butter aromas, and citrusy palate. Matches well with fresh water fish and white meats served in sauces. | |
| 3 | Meursault, Marie-Louise Parisot
FRANCE | £39.95 |
| | An open-knit yet rich wine. Mineral elements hover over the hazelnuts and pear fruit while the palate is deep, broad powerfull and lingering. A very sensual wine. | |

FRANCE | £59.95 |
| | Puligny Montrachet has only been producing Chardonnay since WWII but has found its perfect expression with this. Seductive ripe peaches finished with a herb palate. | |

| | The grapes are harvested at night and fermented tank to retain the maximum freshness. Crisp and clean on the palate with tropical fruit and vanilla oak flavours. | |

SE Australia, AUSTRALIA | £15.95 |
| | The grapes for this fresh lemony Chardonnay are sourced from the south east of the country and fermented in tank with no hint of oak, giving a crisp, ripe acidity. | |

ARGENTINA

A new wine-making team took charge in 2004 and have made a positive impact. This Chenin Blanc is a soft easy-drinking wine, crisp with a slightly honeyed palate.



SAUVIGNON BLANC

- 12 Tierra Sauvignon Blanc, Maule Valley** £14.50
CHILE

Pale yellow with fresh fruit, citrus and mineral notes and a clean finish.

- 13 Pouilly-Fumé Cuvée du Troncsec,** £28.95
Joseph Mellot, FRANCE

This wine comes from the eastern end of the Loire Valley with the classic gunflint aroma associated with the best wines of this area. From a top quality producer.

- 14 Sancerre Les Collinettes, Joseph Mellot** £29.95
FRANCE ½ Bottle £14.95

Joseph Mellot hits the mark again with this fantastic wine. Stylish and crisp, with blackcurrant leaf and gooseberry aromas filling your senses.

- 15 Veramonte Sauvignon Blanc Reserva,** £19.95
Casablanca Valley, CHILE

A sip of this brought to mind a Mojito I once had. Chive, straw and grass flavours create a real taste of summer.

- 16 Nobilo Southern Rivers Sauvignon Blanc,** £21.95
East Coast, NEW ZEALAND

New Zealand's weather patterns suit Sauvignon Blanc, with cool but sunny conditions creating a slow ripening period. This gives the wine a lively acidity bursting with fresh tropical flavours and a bit of zesty lemon.

- 17 Villa Maria Private Bin Sauvignon Blanc,** £25.50
Marlborough, NEW ZEALAND

A prolonged fruit ripening policy in its vineyard, is directly reflected in the depth and intensity of flavour of this wine. Gooseberry, lime and hints of green peppers fill your mouth.

- 19 Vendange Pinot Grigio, California £16.95
USA

The cooling breezes San Francisco Bay creates the perfect conditions for this Pinot Grigio's character to develop. Delicate apple, pear, nectarine and fruit lychee aromas abound.

- 21 Accademia del Sole Viognier, Calatrasi £16.95
ITALY

The Viognier seems well suited to the dry and warm Sicily climate. The wine exudes classic peach and apricot aromas with a touch of oak and vanilla on the finish.

- 22 Casa La Joya Reserve Gewürztraminer, £15.95
Colchagua Valley, CHILE

A new arrival for Chile, but with its pronounced spicy aromas and flavours, with just a hint of sweetness on the palate, I would say 'keep an eye out for more'.

- 23 Vidal Estate Riesling, Marlborough £18.95
NEW ZEALAND

NZ Rieslings are rapidly gaining reputation and this fine example shows why. Low yields result in intense tropical fruit aromas and flavours and a 'just off dry' finish.

- 28 Château Citran, Cru Bourgeois Haut-Médoc £39.95
FRANCE

One of the best 'Cru Bourgeois Châteaux'. Vanilla and cherry on the palate, with a rich structured style.

- 29 Château Haut-Bages-Averous, Pauillac £69.95
FRANCE - 2001

A second wine of Château Lynch-Bages but by no means second rate!

- 30 Chateau Talbot, 4ème Cru Classé Saint-Julien £94.95
FRANCE - 2001

Its reputation speaks for itself.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON CONT'D

- 32 **Kleine Zalze Cabernet Sauvignon,** £17.95
Coastal Region, SOUTH AFRICA
 From the Wellington vineyards this deep-coloured, rich blackcurranty wine was matured in second and third fill French oak.
- 33 **Casa La Joya Cabernet Sauvignon,** £15.50
Colchagua Valley, CHILE
 The balance of rich berry flavours and a soft minted finish perfected by this family-owned winery.
- 34 **Tintara Horseshoe Row Cabernet,** £19.95
S Australia, AUSTRALIA
 Elegant with ripe blackcurrant and blackberry fruit with subtle notes of cashew nuts on the finish.

SHIRAZ

- 36 **Hardys 'The Riddle' Shiraz-Cabernet,** £15.50
SE Australia, AUSTRALIA

- 80 **Hardys Oomoo Shiraz, McLaren Vale** £23.95
Australia
 Oomoo was amongst the first of Hardys wine labels and has been revived to celebrate the 150th anniversary of Hardys wines. Rich, deep wine a mass of dark berry fruits and a spicy dark character.
- 38 **Robert Mondavi Twin Oaks Shiraz,** £19.95
California, USA
 This wine, from one of the New World's great wine producers, has vibrant and concentrated fruit flavours, dark cherry and plum aromas. Fine tannins.

PINOT NOIR

- 39 **Bourgogne Pinot Noir Couvent des Jacobins,** £27.95
Louis Jadot, FRANCE
 The smell is enchanting. Strawberry, suede and sweet new oak integrate with the taste of warm damp undergrowth and leathery tannins.
- 40 **Vidal Estate Pinot Noir, Hawke's Bay** £27.95
NEW ZEALAND
 Hugh Crichton (wine maker) has produced an extraordinary wine with intense black cherry and violet aromas, some spicy tobacco and dark red fruit on the palate. Not bad from a young vineyard, it goes amazingly with our half shoulder of lamb.

FRANCE ½ Bottle £14.95
 The principal Château of Gerard Milhade and one noted for producing wines of outstanding quality. The wine displays dark chocolate aromas, cherries and black olives.
- 42 Corte Vigna Merlot delle Venezie** £13.50
ITALY

- 43 Casa La Joya Gran Reserve Merlot, Colchagua Valley, CHILE** £19.95
 This wine is made from the oldest Merlot vines on the estate which give it a rich concentration of fruit, an intense colour and a touch of velvet on the palate.
- 45 Berri Estates Merlot, SE Australia** £15.95
AUSTRALIA
 A vibrant Australian Merlot with sweet juicy fruit and soft tannins that linger on the palate.
- 46 Blackstone Merlot, California** £18.95
USA
 A sumptuousness of dark berry and black cherry aromas and spicy clove, generous rich softness and gentle barrique complexity.

- 50 Beaujolais-Villages Combe aux Jacques, Louis Jadot, FRANCE** £23.95
 Low volumes but high quality grapes. The result is a well concentrated, fruity and powerful wine which still has the delicious aromas of fruit and a delicate freshness.
- 51 Fleurie Le Muriennes, Thorin** £23.95
FRANCE
 Light pluggable wine full of summer fruit flavours. Enjoy!

52 Côtes du Rhône, Château Saint-Roman, Cuvée Réservee Grenache, Cinsault and Syrah £17.95
FRANCE

A bright ruby red wine with appealing aromas of peppery spice and soft warm summer fruits. The gentle tannins make this a wine to enjoy young or slightly age.

53 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Cuvée Tradition, Caves Saint-Pierre £29.95

Up to 13 different varieties used including Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedre, FRANCE

An excellent example of this famous southern Rhône appellation. Great richness and complexity, yet smooth and rounded on the finish.

54 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, Bolla Corvina, Corvinone and Rondinella, ITALY £39.95

The most famous red wine from this part of Italy and this version has a lovely richness of cherry fruit, cinnamon and sage flavours with a wonderful earthy finish.

55 Chianti Classico Santedame, Ruffino Sangiovese, Cabernet and Merlot, ITALY £22.95

The Santedame estate is located right in the heart of Chianti Classico area. The wine is medium-bodied and elegant, balancing sweet velvety tannins with a fruity core.

56 Cullinan View Pinotage, Robertson SOUTH AFRICA £17.50

South Africa's own grape is a crossing of Pinot Noir and Cinsault, providing lovely fruit, a smoky character and soft tannins.

57 Errázuriz Carmenère, Aconcagua Valley CHILE £19.50

This beautifully balanced wine has soft velvety tannins, a rich mouth feel, toasty oak notes and hints of tobacco and caramel.

58 Finca Flichman Malbec Oak-Aged, Mendoza, ARGENTINA £16.95

A deep violet, cherry flavoured, concentrated black fruit wine which has remarkable complexity and length due to the careful selection of the grapes.

60 Ravenswood Old Vine Zinfandel, Lodi County, USA £25.50

A lush Zin that's concentrated and intense. Soft and rounded, while also spicy and jammy, the wine displays voluptuous overtones of plums and blueberries.

Vibrant rosé made in an off-dry style, lovely crisp zing with summer berry fruit flavours.
- 62 Faustino V Rioja Rosado** £19.95
SPAIN
Bright pink with a fresh strawberry and raspberry nose, complicated by a hint of tangerine. Medium-bodied and bright, with fresh red berry fruit dusted by minerals.
- 63 Sancerre Rosé Le Rabault, Joseph Mellot** £25.95
FRANCE
A real rarity, made from Pinot Noir. The result is a delicate dry pink wine with a delicious aroma of fresh strawberries.

- 64 Muscat de Beaumes de Venise, Cave des Vignerons, FRANCE** ½ Bottle £14.50
125ml Glass £4.95
Floral, both on the nose and in the mouth, yet full-bodied and very chewy.



CHAMPAGNE

- 65 Piper-Heidsieck Brut** £37.00
Our new House Champagne, and one of the Grand Marques made in a forward and approachable style with rich fruit and a refreshing citrusy edge. ¼ Bottle £11.95
- 66 Piper-Heidsieck Rosé Sauvage Brut** £44.00
The wine has a beautiful deep pink colour and a full-bodied palate full of fresh oranges and red summer fruit flavours.
- 67 Laurent-Perrier Brut L.P.** £40.00
A good match for light seafood dishes due to its lightness and freshness. The nose is delicate while the palate is crisp and fresh with a full fruit flavour.
- 68 Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut** £70.00
The wine displays a very light yet persistent fizz, the nose has notes of citrus and biscuit while the palate is fruity with a dry finish.
- 71 Dom Pérignon Brut - 2000** £140.00
Moët & Chandon's luxury cuvée which is consistently ranked as one of the world's best Champagnes. Floral and honey notes combine with citrus and grilled nut flavours.
